

Setting up on Windows Vista

Important note: Some locations provide wired (plugged in) broadband services only. Check online at prepay.2degreesbroadband.co.nz to see if your location offers a Wi-Fi connection for tablets and smartphones.

1. Getting started

Open the start menu and type in **Network and Sharing Center** and open the programme.

2. Network and Sharing Center

Select **Set up a connection or network** from the tasks panel. This will open the **Choose a connection option** screen.

3. Choose a connection option

Select **Connect to the Internet** and click on **Next**. If you are asked if you wish to use a connection you already have, choose **No, create a new connection** and click **Next**.

4. How do you want to connect?

Select **Broadband (PPPoE)** by clicking on it. This will open the ISP information window, where you can enter your username and password.

5. Enter your account information

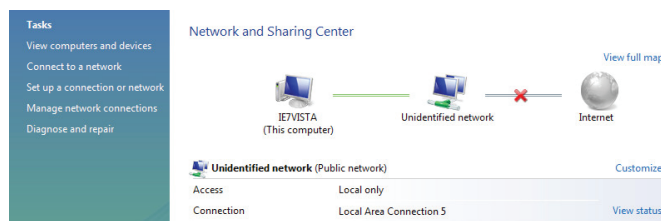
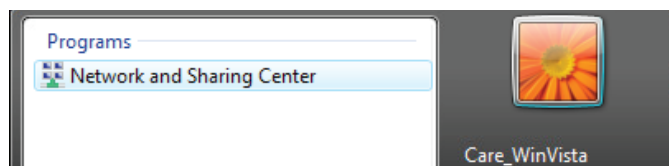
Enter your username into the **User name:** field, and your password into the **Password:** field.

Remember to enter your username in the format `username@prepay.snap.net.nz` – the full username (including `@prepay.snap.net.nz`) is needed for the system to log you on.

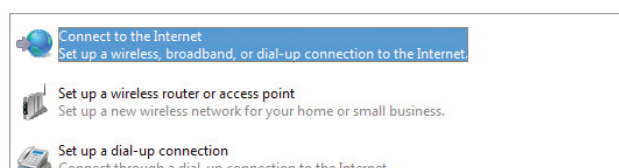
Set the connection name to '2degrees Broadband' so that you can identify it later on. Click **Next**.

6. Connecting

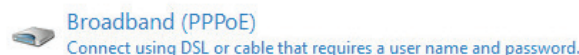
Click **Connect** at the bottom of the **Connect to the Internet** window. Your computer will connect to 2degrees Broadband.

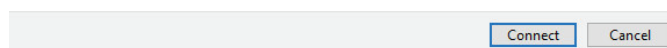
