

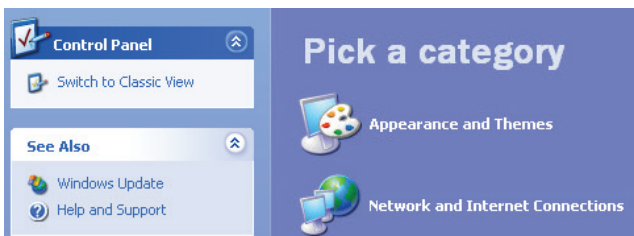
Setting up on Windows XP

Important note: Some locations provide wired (plugged in) broadband services only. Check online at prepay.2degreesbroadband.co.nz to see if your location offers a Wi-Fi connection for tablets and smartphones.

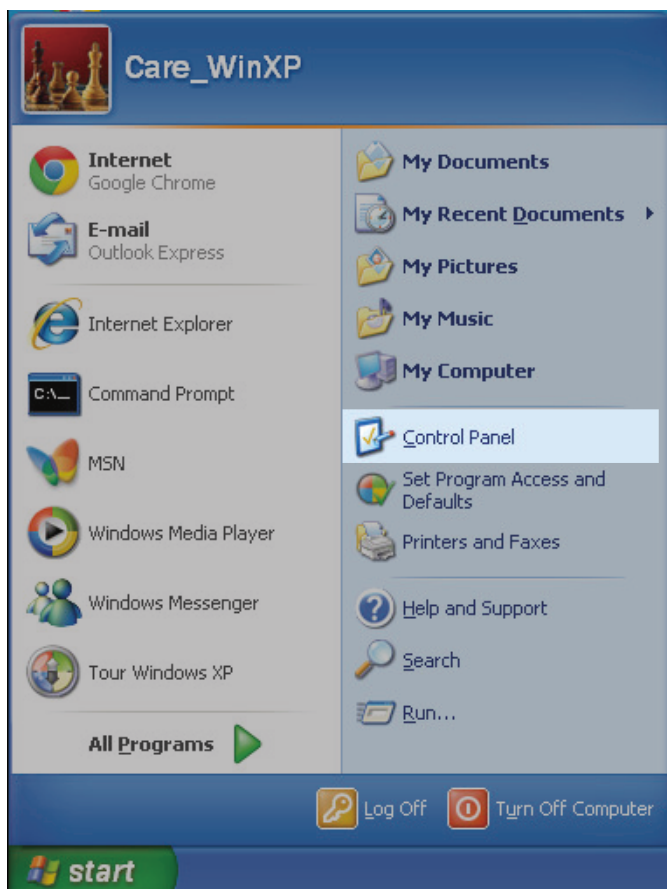
1. Getting started

Open the start menu and open **Control Panel**.

Click on **Switch to Classic View**.

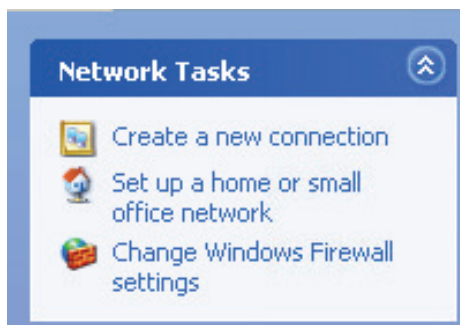


Double click on **Network Connections**.



2. New connection

Select **Create a new connection** from the **Network Tasks** panel.



3. Connection wizard

In **New Connection Wizard** click on **Next**.


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4. What do you want to do?

Select **Connect to the Internet**.

Click **Next**.



5. Connection type

Select **Set up my connection manually**.

Click **Next**.



Select **Connect using a broadband connection that requires a username and password**.


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7. Connection name

Enter a name for your connection (we recommend 2degrees Broadband). Click **Next**.

8. Enter your account information

Enter your username into the **User name:** field, and your password into the **Password:** field.

Remember to enter your username in the format abc123@prepay.snap.net.nz – the full username (including @prepay.snap.net.nz) is needed for the system to log you on.

Set the connection name to '2degrees Broadband' so that you can identify it later on. Click **Next**.
